Baxter Brewing Race League Protocol

The team fee is \$250 for the season. This fee helps to offset the cost of running the races each week and other logistical expenses. Additionally there is a fee of \$17 per racer per night, (Lost Valley Pass holders pay \$12). This includes lift ticket from 6pm-8pm, your race fee for the night, prize ticket and buffet. All racers go to ticket window to registration each week to confirm Racer Number and obtain raffle ticket. There are no Race Bibs, you are responsible for remembering and telling the starter your Racer Number in order to have your times count for the night. Prizes are given out in the lounge area after the race. Prize drawings start at 8:30pm. The race staff will do their best to get results out by 8:45pm. Individual results are found on Live-Timing.com after the race. Team results will be posted on our website each by each Tuesday following each race.

The Baxter Race League will run evenings for 10-weeks starting **January 8th, 2026**. The first night is a practice night. Team captains will also be able to sign independent free agents, can sign up to 20 members anytime of the season, and their score will count for “next” race (cannot add independents night of race). The last night is a costume party night, fun runs and awards will be presented. We will not race during Feb vacation (**Off Feb 19th**). 8 weeks of scoring, costume and awards night will be March 13th.

The race is a modified Giant Slalom held on Big Buck. It is dual courses with one run on each—Red and BLUE—and the total of your first run on each is combined for your score within your division. The race course will be open from 6:00pm-7:45pm. Each racer must take their runs anytime in these hours. Any racer who fails to take their runs will be assigned a DNS (Did Not Start). Any Racer who does not complete the course will be assigned a DNF (Did not Finish). Or, if a racer does not complete the course legally, they will receive a DSQ (Disqualification). Fun Runs will be allowed AFTER YOU COMPLETE YOUR RACE RUNS. Please tell the starter FUN RUN and your race number. Every attempt will be made to announce the time and the scoreboards over the timing building should display your run times. Race Runs always move ahead of Fun Runs. Please yield to Race Runs if you are fun running.

There are no Gatekeepers on the hill; our best effort is made to run a fair race from the start and timing buildings. If you miss a gate, you can hike and get it (your score will count.. If you miss a gate and inadvertently cross the finish line, please notify the race crew scorer in timing shack. Only race under your Racer Number. Knowingly letting someone else race (ghost running) with your number or racing under the wrong number is an offense and the racer or team will face a -50 point penalty. The race director for the night will make the decisions. Rulings that do not appear clear will go to the jury. The jury is comprised of any league Captains present in the bar at the time.

A Team can add a to roster at any time if less than 20. They can drop a member if they quit. After week 4 you can drop members who don't show. They cannot pick up a member who is on another roster “or” who has been on another roster. If not on a team, we accept independents. They can be assigned to a team later if they want to. Their scored race cannot to apply to a Team Score until they sign in for a race under the applicable team. **Captains, please notify Scott Berube of all new (added) members, roster adjustments, or attained independents by Tuesday 5pm prior to the next Thursdays Race (207 33 3 9351)**

CANCELLATIONS: Lost Valley will decide if the race cannot be held due to poor course conditions. Team Captains will be notified by 3pm on Day of Race.

REFUNDS: Lost Valley will make every effort to reschedule a race. Rescheduling will depend on length of the season and snow conditions. There are no refunds.

WINNER: The team with the highest points each week. The total of best 7 weeks are added to determine to winning team for the season (we drop the lowest team score for each team). The Season Champions will be announced at the end of season celebration (Costume Race Night). and receive the Grand Prize, Baxter Jackets for the winning team (members must have participated in at least 6 scored races to receive jacket).

RESULTS: Live-Timing.com has individual results. Top scorers will be recognized at 8:45pm race night and official Team scores will be posted Lost Valley Website by the following Thursday evening.

WEEKLY APPETIZERS: After race buffet opens at 7:30pm, please show raffle ticket.

WEEKLY PRIZES: These are drawn during the post race party in the Lounge at 8:30pm

Team Host Nights: Each race will feature a Team. The team is responsible to be at the start at 7:40 sharp with no poles (expectation is 6 or more members) to help take down course. The gates have to be taken down then “carefully” brought up the chair if it is still open and put at top warming hut. The team is also responsible for rolling up the two blue finish nets (please roll “up” hill). Scott will arrange and notify Host Night schedule. The Team will be recognized during awards after each race and have a chance to promote their sponsor.

Current Rules:

- * 20 Team members 21+ any gender or discipline (all can race)
- * Team Rosters are **due to Scott by email by Dec 23rd**. If you do not have a full roster, submit it any way—**teams can add members at any time of the season (up to 20)**. Be sure to choose the discipline you want to compete in; it cannot be changed once first scoring race is in the books. A roster “sub” can only be made due to injury or life event approved by captains. If you have more than 20 people that want to join—please direct spill over to Scott Berube to have them placed on a team. The classes are Mski Fski Mboard Fboard (tele skiers will be ranked with skiers).
- * **Scoring:** The top 10 scorers per team will be recorded to apply to weekly team score. Top finisher in the each category will receive 50 pts—descending to 10th for 41 pts, that cascades by –1 and repeats as many times as necessary, dictated by category field size (11th place = 49 pts, 21st place = 48 pts etc). In the event of a tie; the tied spot will get the points— everyone else is pushed down. A 3+ pnt bonus will be applied to all participants 65 yo +. The Team with the most points at end of season wins. Each Team will count their best 7 of 8 scores for the season.
